**Topic:** Excluding Persons with Communicable Diseases from School

**Summary:** As it pertains to school districts, this Act amends OKLA. STAT. tit. 63, § 1-507 to forbid a student with a communicable disease from attending a public or private school, and require the parent or guardian and school district (no longer “teacher”) of such a student to exclude that student from school until the expiration of the period of isolation or quarantine ordered for the case, or until permission to do so shall have been given by the local county health department or the State Department of Health.
