Topic: Student ID Cards—Suicide Prevention and Crisis Hotline Numbers

Summary: Senate Bill 1307 (the "Bill") creates new law to be codified at OKLA. STAT. tit. 70,

§ 24-100.10 and prescribes certain requirements for schools that require students

to carry identification cards.

Inclusion of Certain Hotline Numbers on Student ID Cards

For school districts and charter schools that serve students in grades seven (7) through twelve (12) and issue student identification cards, the Bill requires districts to print—on either side of the card—the telephone numbers for the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline and the Crisis Text Line.

Use of Non-compliant ID Cards Currently in a School's Possession

The Bill provides that a school, which currently has a supply of unissued student ID cards that does not comply with the provisions of the new statute as of July 1, 2023, may continue to issue the non-compliant ID cards until its supply is depleted. Lastly, the Bill specifies that its provisions apply to student ID cards that are issued for the first time or as replacements for lost or damaged cards.
