**Topic:** Homeless Students

Summary: This bill creates a new law (70 O.S. § 1210.210) requiring the State Department

of Education to adopt a standard form to be used by all school districts to identify

students who are homeless children and youth.

Beginning with the 2024-2025 school year, the form shall be completed annually at enrollment by the parent or guardian or by the student if the student is not in the physical custody of a parent or guardian.

A district shall report to the State Department no later than June 1 of each year regarding the results of the form collection process. The Department will then create an annual report for review by the Governor and select legislators.
