Topic: **Law enforcement elective course**

Summary: This bill adds a new law (70 O.S. §11-103.15) that allows school districts to offer an elective law enforcement course to students in grades 11-12. The course shall, at a minimum, include instruction in the following:

- A general introduction to law enforcement training;
- Critical skills and entry requirements for law enforcement professionals; and
- Career opportunities in law enforcement.

The State Board of Education may coordinate with the CLEET to develop instructional materials and curricula for school districts to use in the course, and may issue rules to implement the provisions of the new law.
