## **RED BANNER UPDATE**

**Topic:** Oklahoma Open Meeting Act

**Summary:** This bill amends current law (25 O.S. § 311) to remove a provision regarding the

making of public meeting notices available at a principal office or meeting location during the COVID-19 pandemic. The amendment also adds new language to the act which stipulates that all state public bodies as defined in the statute, shall at least twenty-four (24) hours prior to regularly scheduled meetings,

display public notice of the meeting by:

(1) posting information that includes date, time, place and agenda for the meeting in prominent public view at the principal office of the public body or at the location of the meeting if no office exists, and

(2) posting on the public body's Internet website the date, time, place and agenda for the meeting in accordance with Section 3106.2 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
