## RED BANNER UPDATE

**Topic:** Graduation Curriculum Requirements

**Summary:** This bill *further* revises existing law (70 O.S. § 11-103.6) regarding requirements for graduation with a standard diploma. During the session we issued a Red Banner Alert for HB 3278 regarding the revised graduation requirements. After that bill was passed, a second bill was passed to include the following provision for the upcoming school year:

“Beginning with the 2024-2025 school year, students whose parent or legal guardian approve modification of the existing graduation track, subject to school approval, may complete a minimum of twenty-three (23) curriculum units or sets of competencies at the secondary level...”

The 23 units/sets are detailed in the bill which accompanies this alert and HB 3278.
