Emergency Medical Technician (EMT)

DESCRIPTION:

In this career option, students learn skills including airway management, patient assessment, responding to and treating patients in common medical emergencies, as well as, how to manage trauma patients. They will gain fundamental knowledge of EMS operational roles and responsibilities, including ethics, to ensure safe and effective response, scene management, and transport of patients. Students practice in a variety of settings as chosen by the instructor. Students must obtain EMT certification to work in this field. This career option is based upon successful completion of all EMT competencies (didactic, psychomotor and affective domains). Classroom activities, lecture and clinical training are all involved in the completion of this career option. NWTC is accredited by the Oklahoma State Department of Education, The Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education.
