Definitions

Hazing: "Hazing" means any intentional, knowing, or reckless act committed by a person (whether individually or in concert with other persons) against another person or persons regardless of the willingness of such other person or persons to participate, that is committed in the course of an initiation into, an affiliation with, or the maintenance of membership in, a student organization and includes conduct such as, but not limited to physical acts, for example, hipping, beating, branding, electronic shocking, and applying harmful substances, extreme calisthenics, exposure to the elements, causing or coercing another person to consume food, liquid, alcohol, drugs, or other substances, causing or coercing sleep deprivation, exposure to the elements, confinement in a small space, causing or coercing another person to perform sexual act(s), any activity that places another person in reasonable fear of bodily harm through the use of threatening words or conduct, criminal activities, conduct that induces another to commit a crime, and activities which would induce extreme mental and/or physical stress such conduct that could cause extreme embarrassment or humiliation. Finding of Responsibility: A final institutional decision that a hazing violation occurred.

Sanctions: Students violating these prohibitions shall not be permitted to participate in any extra-curricular activity sponsored by the technology center, shall be subject to disciplinary measures which may include suspension or removal, and shall, when appropriate, be referred to local law enforcement authorities for prosecution.
