- DESCRIPTION:**

In this program, students use Adobe Photoshop, Adobe Illustrator, iMovie and Adobe Premiere to edit raw video camera and audio footage into final products for viewing. Students learn non-linear computer editing techniques and real-time editing for professional digital video productions. Students also acquire skills in digital photography and learn copyright basics. The Digital Design program is unlike a traditional classroom setting because assignments are available online and through self-paced video training as well as individual and group projects completed in and out of the classroom. Students will have the opportunity to display their work by creating both an online and a print portfolio. This program is accredited by the OSDE and the ODCTE.
