Career Option: Emergency Medical Responder (EMR)

DESCRIPTION:

In this career option, students complete the Health Careers Core Curriculum (Technology Center), Medical Terminology and Anatomy and Physiology, First Aid and Healthcare Provider CPR. Additionally, students learn how to treat and assess patients in emergency medical and trauma situations, including how to treat patients in shock and those who are unconscious. The career option is designed for firefighters, law enforcement personnel, industry and first response providers and it prepares students for testing and registration through the Oklahoma State Department of Health or NREMT as EMR.

WHO CAN ENROLL:

High School Juniors, Seniors and Adults

CERTIFICATIONS/CREDENTIALS:

Students are eligible to test for the following certifications: the State of Oklahoma Emergency Medical Responder Certification, CPR, First Aid, WorkKeys Certifications and National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians (NREMT) EMR.
